

The Robins Chiefs Group Academic Scholarship (High School)

Since its inception, the Robins Chiefs Group has been dedicated to helping deserving individuals achieve their educational goals through its scholarship program. **The Robins Chiefs Group Academic Scholarship (High School)** recognizes graduating high school seniors who possess an outstanding scholastic record. This award is granted based primarily on scholastic achievement. Recipients will receive at least \$500. Up to four scholarships are awarded annually.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. An applicant must be the dependent of an enlisted military member (Active Duty, Reserves, National Guard, retired, or deceased) assigned to or retired from Robins Air Force Base. Any enlisted rank or branch of service is eligible. In the case of retired or deceased sponsors, the applicant must have remained in the Robins AFB area. Proof of dependent status is required.
2. An applicant have graduated from high school in 2022 and must have a grade point average (GPA) at or above 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. Applicants must have applied to, or been accepted at an accredited institution of higher learning (university, college, technical college, etc) for the 2022-2023 academic year. An applicant must also be enrolled as a full-time student at that institution by fall 2022.
3. Applicants who possess a military academy appointment, ROTC scholarship, or any other full four-year scholarship that includes room and board are ineligible for these scholarships. Also ineligible are dependents who receive full tuition payment under coverage provided by the Post-9/11 GI Bill.

PROCEDURE:

A selection panel composed of members of the Robins Chiefs Group will determine the award recipients based primarily on **scholastic achievement** (GPA; SAT or ACT scores; Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, Honors courses completed; and scholastic competitions entered (science and engineering fairs, etc) and awards won). Applicants will also complete a short personal statement outlining their educational goals. Scholarship recipients will be notified of their selection no later than 9 Sep 2022.

The applicant must provide all of the following:

1. Completed Part A of the application signed in the appropriate places.
2. Proof of status of military member and dependent.
3. Typed listing of advanced courses taken and competitions and awards received during high school, divided and titled by category:
 - a. Advanced Courses. List all Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, and Honors courses completed from 9th grade to the present. If currently enrolled in such courses, list those as well.
 - b. Scholastic Competitions and Awards: List all scholastic competitions (science & engineering fairs, math competitions, social studies fairs, etc) entered in high school and awards received. Indicate the year(s) in which the applicant participated. Also indicate if the applicant is a member of the National Honor Society.
4. Typed personal statement of no more than 500 words outlining the applicant's educational goals.
5. Transcript of applicant's final year of high school to include finalized grades.
6. For home schooled children only, in lieu of "5" above:
 - a. A brief explanation of how grades are determined and what curriculum is followed.
 - b. A copy of end-of-year testing scores for the student's previous year.
